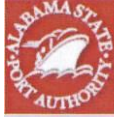

<p>This Requisition solicits proposals to provide structural steel members having grades and dimensions as indicated in the schedule of prices.</p> <p>Sealed bid proposals will be received via courier to the Alabama State Port Authority, 1400 Alabama State Docks Boulevard, Room 216, Administration Building, Mobile, Alabama, 36602 until 9:15 a.m. on Friday September 14, 2018. Sealed bids can also be hand delivered from 9:45 until 10:00 a.m. on Friday, September 14, 2018 to the Alabama State Port Authority in the International Trade Center building, 250 North Water Street, 1st. Floor — Killian Room, Mobile, Alabama. No faxed or electronic bids will be accepted. The official bid opening will be conducted in the Killian Room at 10:00 a.m. on Friday, September 14, 2018. Each submission shall be placed in a sealed envelope with bidder's name, the project name, and the time and date of the bid opening shown on the outside.</p> <p>A Bid Bond (form attached) or Certified Check made payable to the Alabama State port Authority and equal to five (5%) percent of the amount bid, not to exceed \$ 10,000, must accompany the Bid Proposal.</p> <p>The successful Bidder will be required to furnish a Performance Bond in an amount not less than the sum bid at the signing of the contract (form attached). The Bidder shall comply with all Federal and State laws, local ordinances and regulations, and all orders and decrees of bodies or tribunals having any jurisdiction or authority, which in any manner affect those engaged or employed on the contract work, or which in any way affect the conduct of the contract work.</p> <p>The Bidder will be required to complete the delivery under the Contract within 10 calendar days if issuance of the Notice to Proceed or by October 3, 2018, whichever is later. Failure to deliver within the specified time period will initiate liquidated damages in the amount of \$100.00 per calendar day exclusive of Sundays and National Holidays.</p> <p>Compensation for the material shall be as per the Schedule of Prices.</p>	



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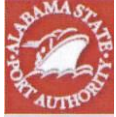

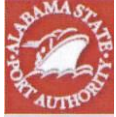
