**23KV Power Cable Replacement**

Subject: Comments based on discussions in 10/5/2021 Pre-Bid Meeting

1. 23KV Cable Replacement – All Cables to be replaced from the fuse blocks to the 23KV Supply switch gear cabinet are to be identical in all respects; Length Type/make, material, insulation, terminations, etc.
2. Alabama Power Contact – Rick Ramirez, Account Manager, Office – 251-694-2540, Cell 251-331-3407
3. ASPA will make arrangements with Alabama Power Co. to disconnect and reconnect (de-energize and re-energize) the incoming 23KV main feeders for the shutdown to isolation of the Dead-End Structure. The power will be shut off from the APCO side at the pole north of and outside the ASPA North Electrical Yard during the shutdown. This will include the overhead incoming feeder lines to the Dead End Structure. The Contractor will be responsible for verification and coordination with APCo & ASPA for the duration of the project and shutdown.
4. The criteria (size, type, speed, etc.) for replacement of fuses on the fused recloser switch must be coordinated with Alabama Power Company.
5. Bids will be based on work being done during week days as required to complete the work in a timely manner. Change orders will be issued for the cost of additional overtime or holiday pay along with any additional work which may result from the survey and inspection of the equipment and apparatus that makeup the switchgear during the shutdown.
6. The actual date and duration of the shutdown for installation of the new 23KV cables will be determined based on the downtime required to complete the work described as determined by the contractor and the facility's operations schedule.
7. The Contractor will replace three insulators at the of the top of Dead-end Structure on the South/ASPA side with new more substantial/upgraded insulators of the same make.  
Line Post Insulator with Universal Clamp - Hubble Catalog Number 80S0250K09.
8. The Contractor will be responsible for all work described in the bid specifications and drawings, including testing of new cables.
9. Due to the unstable market price for copper cable we will allow for a price adjustment on the 25KV cable that is to be supplied by the contractor. In order to qualify for the price adjustment the contractor must submit a copy of the quote from the supplier with their bid. Contractor must also provide a price index for copper in which their quote it based. The price adjustment will be based on the difference in the price index form the date quoted until the date the contract is awarded.
