**IMPORTANT INFORMATION

The transition to the Airbus U.S. Manufacturing Facility will be a parade complete with a jazz band and a float leading the way (**for safety reasons, there will be no throws**).

The parade will depart from the APM Terminals Mobile, travel down Baker and Baker Street Extension. The parade will turn left on Broad Street, and veer right on to 15th Street. The parade will turn right onto Broad Street (again) and proceed down Aerospace Drive/Airbus Way to the Airbus Manufacturing Facility. The four-mile journey from the port will take approximately 30-45 minutes. The parade route along Broad and 15th Street will close to all traffic at 2:15 pm, CDT, for the Parade. The route will reopen at the conclusion of the parade.

<u>The public can access Mobile Aeroplex at Brookley via Michigan Avenue</u>. The public will be directed to available and specified parking on the Aeroplex, and can view the convoy either on Broad Street or 15th Street. <u>For safety reasons, there will be no public viewing (or parking) on Baker Street, Baker Street Extension, Aerospace Drive or Airbus Way.</u>

An area designated for media trucks is located at the entrance to Aerospace Way at the Mobile Aeroplex, if needed. Media organizations do not need to register to locate here.
