

INVITATION TO BID

Sealed bid proposals will be received via courier to the Alabama State Port Authority, 1400 Alabama State Docks Blvd, Room 216, Administration Building, Mobile, AL 36602 by 1:00pm, on Wednesday, September 6, 2017. Sealed bid proposals can also be hand delivered from 1:30 to 2:00pm, on Wednesday, September 6, 2017 to the Alabama State Port Authority in the International Trade Center building, 250 North Water Street, 1st floor – Killian Room, Mobile, AL. Faxed or electronic submitted bids will not be accepted.

BERTH 8 - FENDER REPLACEMENT MOBILE, ALABAMA

The work consists principally of providing bonds, labor, materials, equipment, and supervision necessary to remove the existing deteriorated and damaged timber cribbing fender system and to install a new timber cribbing fender system.

Specifications, proposal forms, bid and performance bond forms, and plans are on file in the office of the Engineering Services Department at the Alabama State Port Authority, Mobile, Alabama. Complete Plans and Specification sets will be furnished to qualified prospective bidders upon payment to Alabama State Port Authority of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars (check or money order only) per set, none of which will be refunded. A Pre-Bid Meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, August 29, 2017 at 10:00 AM in the engineering conference room. Bidder attendance is MANDATORY.

A Guarantee will be required with each bid as follows: At least five (5%) percent of the amount bid, but in no event more than Ten Thousand (\$10,000) Dollars, shall be furnished in the form of a certified check or bid bond payable to the Alabama State Port Authority.

A Performance Bond in an amount not less than the sum bid will be required at the signing of the contract and, in addition, a bond in an amount not less than One Hundred (100%) percent of the contract price, insuring payment of all labor and material.

No bid will be considered unless the bidder, whether resident or non-resident of Alabama, is properly qualified to submit a proposal for this work in accordance with all applicable laws of the State of Alabama. This shall include evidence of holding a current license as required from the State Licensing Board for General Contractors, Montgomery, AL, with the classification being H/RR:Heavy/Railroad. Also, non-residents of the State must show evidence of having qualified with the Secretary of State to do business in AL.

Bids will be publicly opened at 2:00 PM, Wednesday, September 6, 2017, at the Killian Room. The right is reserved, as the interest of the Alabama State Port Authority may require, to reject any and all bids and to waive informalities in bids received.
