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### INVITATION TO BID

Sealed bid proposals will be received via courier to the Alabama State Port Authority, McDuffie Coal Terminal, Attn: Tom Alvarez, 1901 Ezra Trice Blvd., Mobile, AL 36602 by **1:45 P.M., on Tuesday, May 14, 2019**. Sealed bid proposals can also be hand delivered from **1:45 P.M. to 2:00 P.M., on Tuesday, May 14, 2019** to the Alabama State Port Authority in the International Trade Center Building, 250 North Water Street, 1st floor – Killian Room, Mobile, AL. Faxed or electronic submitted bids will not be accepted.

The work consists principally of providing bonds, labor, materials, equipment, and supervision necessary for the removal of existing structural steel trusses, bents, conveyor components and crane rails and fabrication, delivery and installation of new structural steel trusses, bents, conveyor components and crane rails. The Contractor will be required to complete the work under the Contract within 150 calendar days. Actual completion date is unknown due to operations and scheduling of the 25-day shutdown. Fabrication and delivery is expected to be 125 days after receipt of "Notice to Proceed" but there may be a delay in the shipping based upon the actual start date of the shutdown. ASPA will designate the 25-day shutdown for demolition and erection of the new steel as soon as possible after the fabrication.

All Contractors submitting bids are to carefully examine the site of the proposed work by appointment only and thoroughly review the contract requirements prior to submission of a bid proposal. Each Bidder shall satisfy oneself as to the character, quality, and quantities of work to be performed, and as to the requirements of the proposed Contract. The submission of a proposal shall be proof that the bidding Contractor has made such examination and is satisfied as to the conditions to be encountered in performing the work as and as to the requirements of the proposed Contract. All bidding Contractors must hold the proper license from the State Licensing Board of General Contractors, Montgomery, Alabama.

Specifications, proposal forms, bid and performance bond forms, and plans are on file in the office of Aptim Port Services, LLC at 3600 Springhill Business Park, Suite 200, Mobile, Alabama 36608. An **optional** Pre-Bid Meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, April 30, 2019 at 9:00 A.M. at the Alabama State Port Authority in the International Trade Center Building, 250 North Water Street, 1st floor – Killian Room, Mobile, AL. At the conclusion of the **optional** Pre-Bid Meeting a site visit will be offered to allow prospective Contractor's to observe the existing conditions of the site.

A Guarantee will be required with each bid as follows: At least five (5%) percent of the amount bid, but in no event more than Ten Thousand (\$10,000) Dollars, shall be furnished in the form of a certified check or bid bond payable to the Alabama State Port Authority.

Performance and Payment bonds will be required at the signing of the contract in an amount not less than One Hundred (100%) percent of the contract price.

No bid will be considered unless the bidder, whether resident or non-resident of Alabama, is properly qualified to submit a proposal for this work in accordance with all applicable laws of the State of Alabama. This shall include evidence of holding a current license as required from the State Licensing Board for General Contractors, Montgomery, Alabama with the classification being appropriate for this type of work. In addition, non-residents of the State must show evidence of having qualified with the Secretary of State to do business in AL.

Bids will be publicly opened at **2:00 P.M., on Tuesday, May 14, 2019** in the International Trade Center Building, 250 North Water Street, first floor – Killian Room, Mobile, AL. The right is reserved, as the interest of the Alabama State Port Authority may require, to reject any and all bids and to waive informalities in bids received.
