The Invitation to Bid is hereby amended as follows:

Item 1

The date and time for the Bid Opening is changed to Wednesday, June 13, 2018 at 2:00 PM. Sealed bid proposals can be received via courier to the Alabama State Port Authority, 1400 Alabama State Docks Blvd., Suite 200, Administration Building, Mobile, AL 36602 by 1:00 PM on Wednesday, June 13, 2018. **U.S. Postal Service is unable to deliver to this address.** Sealed bid proposals can also be hand delivered at the International Trade Center building, 250 North Water St., Mobile, AL, 36602 30 minutes prior to the official bid opening at 2:00 PM. The bid opening will take place in the Killian Room at the International Trade Center building.

Item 2

ASPA is modifying the ***Scope of Work and Specifications*** to include the following stipulation: Work by the Debris Removal Contractor shall only take place during daylight hours on weekdays (Monday-Friday, excluding State holidays).

Item 3

The ***Bid Bond*** form (page 8 from the RFP) is corrected as follows:

The text "Soil Removal – Baker Street and Bay Avenue in Mobile, Alabama, Project No. 10489, Task No. 1" is replaced with the text "Tropical Weather Debris Removal, Project No. 10457, Task No. 7." A revised Bid Bond is attached with this addendum. If the Bid Bond has already been executed, bidder may strike through the incorrect text, add the correct text, and have an authorized representative initial and date the changes.

 State Port Authority a certain BID, attached hereto and hereby made a part hereof to enter into a
 contract in writing, for the Tropical Weather Debris Removal, Project No. 10457, Task No. 7.

NOW, THEREFORE,

- (a) If said BID shall be rejected, or
- (b) If said BID shall be accepted and the Principal shall execute and deliver a contract in the form of
 Contract attached hereto (Properly completed in accordance with said BID) and shall furnish a BOND for
 his faithful performance of said contract, and for the payment of all persons performing labor or
 furnishing materials in connection therewith, and shall in all other respects perform the agreement
 created by the acceptance of said BID, then this obligation shall be void, otherwise the same shall
 remain in force and effect; it being expressly understood and agreed that the liability of the Surety for
 any and all claims hereunder shall, in no event, exceed the panel amount of this obligation as herein
 stated.

The Surety, for value received, hereby stipulates and agrees that the obligations of said Surety and its
BOND shall in no way be impaired or affected by any extension of time within which the **OWNER** may
 accept such BID; and said Surety does hereby waive notice of any such extension.
