INVITATION TO BID

Sealed bid proposals will be received via courier to the Alabama State Port Authority, 1400 Alabama State Docks Blvd, Room 200, Administration Building, Mobile, AL 36602 by 1:30 PM, on Thursday, April 23rd. Sealed bid proposals can also be hand delivered from 1:45 P.M. to 2:00 P.M., on Thursday, April 23rd to the Alabama State Port Authority in the International Trade Center building, 250 North Water Street, 1st floor – Killian Room, Mobile, AL. Faxed or electronically submitted bids will not be accepted. **PLEASE NOTE THAT ATTENDANCE TO THE BID OPENING IS NOT MANDATORY.**

The work consists principally of providing bonds, labor, materials, equipment, and supervision necessary for the excavation and hauling of dredge material from McDuffie Terminal.

Specifications, proposal forms, bid and performance bond forms, and plans are on file in the office of the Engineering Services Department at the Alabama State Port Authority, Mobile, Alabama. Complete Plans and Specification sets will be furnished to qualified prospective bidders upon payment to Alabama State Port Authority of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars (check or money order only) per set, none of which will be refunded.

A Pre-Bid Meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, April 14th at 10:00 A.M. at the McDuffie Terminal DMMA. All bidders are to meet at 1901 Ezra Trice Boulevard, Mobile, AL, 36603 (30°39'43.63"N 88° 2'7.26"W). If you require an escort for the pre-bid meeting or have a technical request for information (RFI) please contact Wesley Jackson at (251) 441-7253. In the event that an escort is needed, please provide a minimum 24 hour notice. **No same day escorts will be provided.** Those escorted are required to have a valid state or federal identification. All vehicles entering McDuffie Terminal are required to have proof of vehicle registration and insurance. **Bidder attendance is NOT REQUIRED.** However, all bidders are encouraged to carefully examine the site of the proposed work and to thoroughly review the contract requirements prior to the submission of a bid proposal.

Each bidder shall satisfy oneself as to the character, quality, and quantities of work to be performed, and as to the requirements of the proposed contract. The submission of a proposal shall be proof that the bidding Contractor has made such examination and is satisfied as to the conditions to be encountered in performing the work and as to the requirements of the proposed Contract. All bidding Contractors must hold a current license from the State Licensing Board for General Contractors, Montgomery, Alabama with the classification being H/RR: Heavy & Railroad Construction, H/RR-S: Heavy & Railroad Construction – Earthwork, or H/RR-S: Heavy & Railroad Construction – Dredging, Levees, and Dikes.

A Guarantee will be required with each bid as follows: At least five (5%) percent of the amount bid, but in no event more than Ten Thousand (\$10,000) Dollars, shall be furnished in the form of a certified check or bid bond payable to the Alabama State Port Authority.

A Performance Bond in an amount not less than the sum bid will be required at the signing of the contract and, in addition, a bond in an amount not less than One Hundred (100%) percent of the contract price, insuring payment of all labor and material.

No bid will be considered unless the bidder, whether resident or non-resident of Alabama, is properly qualified to submit a proposal for this work in accordance with all applicable laws of the State of Alabama. This shall include evidence of holding a current license as required from the State Licensing Board for General Contractors, Montgomery, Alabama. Also, non-residents of the State must show evidence of having qualified with the Secretary of State to do business in AL.

Bids will be publicly opened at 2:00 P.M., on Thursday, April 23rd, at the Alabama State Port Authority in the International Trade Center building, 250 North Water Street, 1st floor – Killian Room, Mobile, AL. The right is reserved, as the interest of the Alabama State Port Authority may require, to reject any and all bids and to waive informalities in bids received.
